

## Sustainability at Vrissaki Beach Hotel

Vrissaki Beach Hotel is continually working to improve the impact we have on people and places.

We are committed to reducing our greenhouse gas emissions and to protecting and supporting biodiversity. We support the conservation of local endemic species, fauna and flora, through raising awareness among stakeholders and minimizing environmental pollution. As part of that commitment, in 2023 we set ourselves a target of reducing our environmentally hazardous substances by 3% at the end of 2024. We are pleased to report that as of 30<sup>th</sup> September 2024, we have achieved a reduction of approximately 25%.

We acknowledge that there are areas where our environmental efforts have fallen short, with some indicators showing an increase and certain targets not being met as planned. To address this, we are actively implementing new initiatives across our operations to help us meet our sustainability goals. We are encouraging our valued guests, staff and visitors to support us by following the reminders we have provided throughout the hotel about saving water and energy, as well as minimizing waste.

We are proud of the fundraising activities led by our dedicated staff, which have been instrumental in achieving our objectives. Every year, on the last day of the hotel season, we organize a special lunch for children with special needs from Apostolos Pavlos School in Liopetri. Additionally, in 2023, we introduced a donation box at the reception where guests can contribute to the "Paralimni Dog Pound Rescue." Thanks to the continued generosity of our guests, this initiative has become a meaningful way for us to give back to the community.
