

Sustainability at Vrissaki Beach Hotel

Vrissaki Beach Hotel is continually working to improve the impact we have on people and places. We are committed to reducing our greenhouse gas emissions and to protecting and supporting biodiversity. We support the conservation of local endemic species, fauna, and flora through raising awareness among stakeholders and minimizing environmental pollution.

As part of our 2024 sustainability commitment, we set ambitious targets to reduce our total energy consumption (kWh), water usage, and solid waste generation (kg). Over the year, we achieved a nearly 2% reduction in total energy use, an impressive 26% decrease in water consumption, and an approximate 14% reduction in total waste. These results demonstrate that through teamwork and focused actions, meaningful change is possible whether large or small.

We are actively implementing new initiatives across our operations to help us meet our sustainability goals. We are encouraging our valued guests, staff, and visitors to support us by following the reminders we have provided throughout the hotel about saving water and energy, as well as minimizing waste.

We are proud of the fundraising activities led by our dedicated staff, which have been instrumental in achieving our objectives. Every year, on the last day of the hotel season, we organize a special lunch for children with special needs from Apostolos Pavlos School in Liopetri. Additionally, we continue our donation box at the reception, where guests can contribute to the *"Paralimni Dog Pound Rescue."* Thanks to the continued generosity of our guests, this initiative remains a meaningful way for us to give back to the community.

Vrissaki Beach Hotel is equally committed to respecting and protecting human rights. We believe that everyone should be treated fairly and with respect, and we are dedicated to safeguarding the welfare of children and young people. We have a strict policy of reporting any suspected instances of child exploitation and abuse to the local authorities.
